

Year 6 transition update from QEHS:

I hope you and your families are all keeping safe and well during these unprecedented times.

I know that this is a very unsettled time for many Year 6 pupils but please be assured that we will give them our full attention when they start with us in September.

We have just received confirmation that September 1st and 2nd will be non-contact days and then the 3rd and 4th September will be for our new year 7 pupils. They will get to meet and spend time with their form tutor and form class. This will also allow them time to familiarise themselves with the building and to find their way around. It will also be an opportunity for the pupils to follow a timetable and meet their subject teachers.

On the 3rd of September, only year 7 and year 12 will be on site.

On the 4th of September, only year 7, along with year 10 and 12, will be on site.

The following week, year 7's will be back full time along with our other year groups by Wednesday 9th September 2020.

There will be a staggered lunchtime and it hasn't yet been decided if they will be able to have lunch from the school canteen or if it will only be packed lunch for the first few days. If possible, could you let your children know so that they are less anxious about joining us. We will confirm the final plans with parents/carers at the end of this week.
